Want to be an Official Member of St. Paul's?

Did you know it is possible to be a member of St. Paul's without being an official "Episcopalian"?

To be an official member of St. Paul's, we need your baptismal information on file: Date of baptism (if you don't have the exact date, it's okay) and Place of baptism (name of church, denomination, and city).

To be an official Episcopalian, you either need to be baptized in the Episcopal Church (If you are already baptized, this option won't work), or you need to be Confirmed or Received into the Episcopal Church. (Bishop's do this during their

annual parish visits.) Currently we are without a bishop. At some point in the next year, we will be visited by an interim/assisting bishop.

EYC "Blessing Bags"

The EYC (Episcopal Youth Community) will once again be collecting items for "Blessing Bags" and we need your help! A blessing bag is a Ziplock bag stocked with food, toiletries, and other items one might need while living on the street. The youth will distribute some of the bags

to people in need in downtown Reno. On a future Sunday, the youth will also help the congregation assemble bags to take to their cars and be handed out when needed.

We are doing the donations similar to the tags we pull at Christmas for toy donations. Tags with suggested donation items will be on a tree in the Narthex beginning **Sunday**, **January 13**. You can pick a tag and then bring your donation back to the church by the deadline of **Sunday**, **February 10**.

Toiletries should be travel or hotel sized, and food items should be in small, individually wrapped packages. The point is for them to fit into a gallon sized Ziplock bag.

Some of items that will be listed on the tags are: gallon sized Ziplock bags, granola bars, cereal bars, snack crackers, small peanut butter packets, small beef jerky packets, small almond packets, small boxes of raisins, applesauce or fruit cups/pouches, juice boxes/pouches, packets of trail mix, gum, small and regular sized bottled water, pop top meat or sausages, hand sanitizer bottles or wipes, baby wipes, toothbrush/toothpaste, wash cloths, shampoo, lotion, combs, nail clippers, deodorant, socks, lip balm and travel sized tissues.

Prayers and Squares Ministry

Prayers & Squares meets in the Parish Hall on the 4th Saturday of each month, where quilts are cut out, sewed, and prayer threads inserted. Knowing how to sew is not necessary as there are many other tasks involved in making the quilts. Everyone is welcome. When the quilts are completed, they are placed in the new Quilt Cabinet in the Narthex. Anyone can view and select a quilt for someone in need.
