## From the Pile on Fr. Kirk's Desk...



Dear St. Paul's,

**Are we fully in the GREEN?**

**Can we gather in person to worship?**

**Answer: No, not yet. We are still in the Red.**

Things still have to happen before we will reopen for public worship.

### **#1 Governor Sisolak has to permit it**

In phase 2, the Governor has okayed 50 people or less to gather for worship, as long as 6 feet can be maintained between congregants.

### **#2 Bishop Waggoner has to permit it (It's no longer the Bishop making this decision)**

We have been given guidelines, not from Bishop Waggoner, but by the President of the Standing Committee of the Diocese. We have to submit a detailed plan to the Diocese stating how we will reopen safely. That plan has to be approved by the President of the Standing Committee and the Diocesan Chancellor. Some benchmarks that have to be met before we can meet in the church:

- **A 14-day downward or perfectly flat trend in COVID-19 cases is reported in Washoe County as reported by the State of Nevada in its update beginning on Tuesday morning, June 16, 2020.** (If we reach this benchmark, we can only stay open as long as this benchmark remains)

- **Testing is reasonably available and being practiced in the city in which the parish is located.**

- **The nearest major hospital or regional medical center which would treat a positive**

**case is doing so without yet being in "crisis mode."** (This benchmark has to be maintained)

**IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER:** The more people that don't follow social distancing guidelines including wearing a mask while around people they don't live with, the longer it will take for us to re-open.

### **#3 Submit our Plan for Re-opening**

Some of the details in this plan are guided by the Diocese, but will be a bit different for each parish. We are working on this plan, but is a mute point until we reach a 14-day downward or perfectly flat trend in positive cases.

### **#4 Our plan has been approved by the President of the Standing Committee and the Chancellor of the Diocese.**

### **#5 After all this,.. Fr. Kirk has set our re-opening date!**

Once we get the green light from the Diocese, I (Fr. Kirk) will prayerfully consider if it is safe to proceed.

We will survive. The Gospel will continue. Love will prevail. Be the Good in the world. Reach out to your friends and neighbors. Give them a call, they need to hear from you.

## Lament Writing Workshop

### Holy Anger Unleashed

How can we pray when we're hurting?  
How can we come before God with our raw, honest emotions?  
How can we wrap all of the feelings swirling around in our big hearts into prayer?

The ancient biblical writers have given us a gift in the form of laments. About one third of our Psalms are lament, and other biblical writers, especially the prophets, offer prayers of pain and distress to God.

God hears our pain and suffering. There's no need to hide it; no need to sugar-coat things with God. In these times of heart-breaking struggle, we can bring before God all of our honest emotions, worries, rages, and concerns.

Join the Rev. Carrie Schofield-Broadbent, from the Diocese of Central New York for an hour long workshop on writing our own Psalms of lament. We'll gather by Zoom at 5:30 p.m. (pacific time) on July 15th. We'll learn about the biblical witness of lament, we'll talk about identifying our emotions, and we'll work on each writing our own Psalm of lament.

You don't need to be a "good" writer to participate; this is more about the process than the product. You just need a desire to connect with God and your emotions.
