A Reflection on General Convention

If you read the Epistle last month, you know that this was my first time representing the Episcopal Diocese of Nevada

at General Convention. They were not kidding when they told me it was a sunup to after sundown event.

Some words that come to mind as I reflect on the week are: Grueling, Loving, Exhausting, Thoughtful, Intentional, Complex, Hopeful, and Holy. I have never been in a room listening to such a large group of Episcopal voices. I was reminded of the diversity of our Creator as I witnessed God's story, God's Love, being shared as lived experience through every shade of skin, gender, sexual orientation, neurodiversity, and multiple cultural truths.

Their stories revealed a great love, respect, and dignity for their neighbors, those close to home and those around the world. Frustration arose when our great love, respect, and dignity for our neighbors was presented with only holy words and not a path for holy action. Thoughts and prayers are good when that is the only option, but they fall short when we yield to them out of the preservation of our own comfort and traditions.

We elected The Rt. Rev. Sean Rowe as our new Presiding Bishop who will be installed in a few months. I believe the perspectives of being Gen X with help Bishop Rowe bridge the gaps and connect the younger and older generations of Episcopalians around the Church. Google him and get to know him. #### **Tech Team**

St. Paul's relies on technology to facilitate both live and online communication. Our Technical Team Ministry (Tech Team) is essential in making this happen.

The team utilizes the Zoom platform to ensure all parishioners can access church services. Our services are hybrid, available both in person and via Zoom.

We use cameras to broadcast and record services, sermons, and special events. Currently, we are learning and experimenting with new cameras and camera systems.

A soundboard is used to control the audio, directing it to the church speakers, hearing assistance devices, and Zoom broadcasts. We manage audio feeds from the praise team, choir, clergy, various mics, and auxiliary sound sources, balancing the sound as needed.

The Tech Team relies on each member's unique gifts to contribute to a quality service. Some volunteers have professional tech training and willingly share their skills, while others with an interest are being trained. Our team works collaboratively, so every member does not need

to know every aspect of our technology. The goal is to have team members on a rotating schedule to run the cameras, Zoom, and assist with the soundboard. Members will also help install and maintain equipment and contribute to discussions about future improvements.

Currently, our team is very small, and we need more members to achieve our goals. Please consider if this is something you are interested in. It helps if you have technical aptitude and are comfortable with computers, but even if you are unsure, a willingness and patience to learn and contribute are valuable.

We ask that anyone interested in joining the Tech Team be committed to the church and our ministry, available to support technical aspects during services, and trainable in new and expanding technologies. This includes working with the soundboard, running camera systems, assisting with wireless microphones and hearing assistance devices, troubleshooting projectors, managing Zoom sessions, recording services, and helping produce a service that all parishioners can participate in, whether in church or at home. Once you join the Tech Team, we ask that you have grace, an open mind, a willingness to learn, and dedication to assisting with all technical matters before, during, and after services.

- Cross on southside facing the school needs sanding/paint and reattached.
